1. Presentation of Schematic Design

- RB+B presented the schematic design. See attached Power Point handout.
- The site plan has been further developed with play areas, plazas and amphitheater to the SE of the building. A photovoltaic panel arbor along the south provides shelter for bike parking, shading for the Admin offices and a tie between the old and new buildings.
- Classrooms and auditorium have been further developed and are shown in plan with proposed furniture layouts and built-in casework.
- Lower level parking with a connection to Building Services and Mechanical and Electrical in the crawl space is provided.
- Building sections show daylighting concept of providing natural light to classrooms and common spaces.

- Elevations and Sketch-Up model indicate masonry, glass and metal siding.
- LEED design meetings have been held with the engineering consultants. We are still on track to achieve a LEED Gold rating.

2. Comments

- Cafeteria size – need plenty of space for socializing and eating
 - o Think about area for table and chair storage
- Entry courtyard very inviting. Community usage will be high on the weekends. May want a security camera.
- Thinness of columns at main entry needs work
- Graffiti on masonry is a concern
- Boulders in entry courtyard should be inviting to sit on
- Need laundry facility – one each front end load washer and dryer – large residential type for washing athletic uniforms, cleaning rags, etc.
- Text book storage by department: math, social studies – could use rooms in classroom groupings on each floor
- Concern about stairs that are enclosed. Look into rolling gate (shutter) for stair at east end instead of double doors.
- Need access from south gym entry to path down to field. Provide gate in east side of fence by BB
- Lou is checking with Xcel to underground power on south side of school
- There will be interim presentation from transportation study
- DD presentation will be next, date to be determined.
- Kristen and Elene have survey inventory of existing items to re-use
- Benches (wooden) in gym now – reuse somewhere (outside?)
- Gym locker rooms to have ability to add showers in the future.

This was the final Schematic Design review meeting. RB+B and Consultants will continue to meet with District and Casey staff to refine the design.
