Safe Schools

ADOPTED: March 13, 2001
REVISED: November 27, 2001

The Board of Education recognizes that effective learning and teaching takes place in a safe, secure, and welcoming environment. Safe schools are a priority in the mission of the Boulder Valley School District and contribute to improved attendance, increased student achievement, and community support. To that end and in accordance with § 22-33-109.1, C.R.S., the Board has adopted the following policies and procedures as part of the District's safe schools plan that includes:

1. A student conduct and discipline code. (See JFC, Student Conduct, and subcodes; and JG, Student Discipline, and subcodes.)
2. Safe school reporting requirements.
3. Staff security and safety.
4. Crisis management.
5. Procedures that address safety and security concerns within the District.
6. Procedures that address the sharing of student information with other agencies, in accordance with applicable state and federal law.
7. Procedures that address persons visiting school buildings and attending school-sponsored activities.
8. Procedures that address the screening of employees subsequent to employment for criminal offenses.
9. Staff dress code.
10. Procedures that address bullying prevention and education.
