**BOARD MEMBER QUALIFICATIONS
(And Nomination)**

Under Colorado statutes:

1. Any candidate for the office of school director of a school district shall be a registered elector of such district and, since the Boulder Valley School District RE2 has a director district plan of representation, he shall be a resident of the director district in which he is a candidate.

2. Any person who desires to be a candidate for the office of school director shall file a written notice of such intention with the Secretary of the Board of Education of the School District, at least 45 days before the election date, together with a nomination petition, signed by at least 50, or 15 percent, whichever is less, of the registered electors residing in the director district in which the person is a candidate. The nomination petition shall contain the name and term of the office for which the person is nominated and his post office address and place of residence. Each of the electors signing the same shall add to his signature his place of residence.

3. A candidate for the office of school director shall not run as a candidate of any political party for that school directorship.
