They have been exploring various topics of study and are in the process of answering all their "*I wonder...*" questions using comprehension strategies and picture research. They will become the experts on their topics of interest and teach the rest of the class and the greater school community about their inquiries. They are so excited to share their background knowledge and their new schema on Penguins, Killer Whales, Leopard Seals, Weddell Seals, Krill, Skua, Ice Fish, and life in Antarctica. We will continue our Social Studies unit on Antarctica through mid April:

Our Thematic Unit activities will include:

Literacy:

- Antarctica research; inquiry posters/mural and presentations
- Penguin Sequencing: egg to chick (labeling/vocabulary)
- Individual Antarctica books (patterned text)

Math:

- Penguin Math: (addition/subtraction and story problems)
- Domino Math (addition/subtraction/number combinations)
Black and White like penguins and killer whales!
- Measuring/Comparing Antarctic Animals (non-standard units)

Science:

- Ice/Crystal observations
- Blubber experiment (adaptation)
- Antarctic Animal Food Web

Geography:

- Map and Globe skills/symbols
- Continents

- Creating individual Antarctica Maps (focusing on symbols, directions, inhabitants, and characteristics)

- Penguin Puppets
- Magazine collage penguins
- Epson Salt creations
- Ice and water exploration
