**-Sat, Oct. 10: Arapahoe Invitational Marching Band Festival** at Littleton Public Schools Stadium (LPS), 199 E. Littleton Blvd, Littleton, CO 80121.

Spectators: There is limited spectator parking in the lot between Littleton HS and the Stadium, but those who are handicapped and have limited walking ability may be dropped off here, while the driver parks the car. Overflow parking will be available at the old Burt GMC lot on S. Broadway. Ticket prices are \$12 adults, \$7 students for prelims or finals, or \$20 adults, \$12 students for a combo ticket to prelims or finals. Children are admitted free.

Students: Watch for Mr. Keller's Dope Sheet for specific times. Tentatively, band practice will be from 8:45-10:45 AM with lunch served at 11 AM, call time at 11:45 AM, preliminary performance at 3 PM, dinner served around 5:15 PM, Finals performance TBA, and busses return to Fairview around 11:30 PM.

**-Mon, Oct. 12: CBA Denver Metro Qualifying Regionals** at Littleton Public Schools Stadium, same location as Sat. This performance determines FMK's placement for the State competition.
