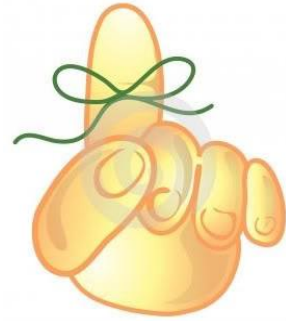
This one is long but cool:
