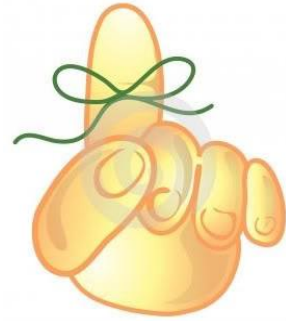
CAP Action Project Schedule--Just Say NO, to GMOs!
