

Roche Colorado Regional Science Fair Grand Awards Policy

- First place senior division projects in each category, whether they are individual or team projects, will receive a \$100.00 US Savings Bond, a certificate, a blue ribbon, and be eligible for the Roche Colorado Best in Show Award.
- First place junior division projects in each category, whether they are individual or team projects, will receive a \$100.00 US Savings Bond, a certificate, a blue ribbon, and be eligible for the NEW Roche Colorado Junior Cup Award.
- Second place senior and junior division projects in each category, whether they are individual or team projects, will receive a certificate and a red ribbon.
- Third place senior and junior division projects in each category, whether they are individual or team projects, will receive a certificate and a white ribbon.
- 10 senior division and 10 junior division projects will be selected to compete at the Colorado State Science Fair. First place projects do not automatically advance. Second and third place projects may advance if they do not supplant a higher ranking project from the same category. Registration costs for BVSD students will be covered.
- 3 senior division projects will be selected to compete at the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair. First place projects do not automatically advance. Second and third place projects may advance if they do not supplant a higher ranking project of the same category. Expenses for BVSD students will be covered and include: airfare, hotel, ground transportation as needed, registration, shipping, and trading pins.

Special and Regional Awards Policy

- ISEF Special and Regional Awards may include cash awards, scholarships, internships, equipment, certificates, savings bonds, or other items as determined by the award sponsors.
- The criteria and selection process for Special and Regional Awards vary from year to year and a judging committee makes the final award determinations.
- Past awards have included: American Meteorological Society, ASM Materials Education Foundation, Association of Women Geosciences, City of Boulder Water Quality, Colorado Geological Survey, Cosmos Foundation, Intel Computer Science, Mu Alpha Theta, NCAR, Ricoh Corporation, Science in the Service of the Community, Ricoh Corporation, Society for In Vitro Biology, Soil and Water Conservation, Thorne Ecological, University of Colorado Chemistry and Biochemistry Department, US Army, US Department of Health and Human Services, US Metric Association, US Navy / Marine Corps, and the Water Environment Federation.
- New Special and Regional awards for 2011 will include: junior and senior division Student Choice, junior and senior division Teacher Choice, and junior SRS Symposium Invitational awards.
