Olivia Barry and Sawyer Hammond, students at Manhattan Middle School for the Arts and Academics, received the 2007 “Winning Attitude” grand prize from Qwest, FSN Rocky Mountain and the University of Colorado. They were among six middle school students in Colorado who were up for the grand prize. That prize included a \$1,000 contribution to Manhattan and the hosting of a school-wide pep rally with CU Football Coach Dan Hawkins emceed by FSN Rocky Mountain announcers and tickets to the CU/Florida State game. Olivia helped raise awareness in the Boulder area about children in Africa orphaned by HIV and AIDS. She fundraised over \$1,000 through a bake sale for children in Uganda. Sawyer helped children orphaned by AIDS in Zimbabwe. He fundraised \$2,350 by playing the African Marimba, a type of xylophone, on the Pearl Street Mall in Boulder.
